Legal terms:

- «Object»: What you want
- «Grounds»: Why it should be granted
 - If relevant, indicate any emergency relating to your health or safety

— **Submit your application** (between \$40 and \$78)

- In person: bit.ly/TALOffices



As soon as possible, send to the defendant:

- i. A copy of your application; AND
- ii. A copy of your supporting documents (or a list)

➔ with proof of receipt (ex. registered mail)

As soon as possible (max. 45 days from the date of your application), file with TAL:

- i. Proof that the defendant received what you sent
- ii. The complete list of your supporting documents: bit.ly/TALlist

In preparation for your hearing:

- Write out a chronology of the events
- Notify the TAL of any change of address
- Visit www.tal.gouv.qc.ca/en/hearing

Hearing day

- 3 copies of evidence
